Drill holes PC-92-C12 and C13 were drilled 250 feet east and 100 feet above PC-92-C11 respectively, confirming the high grade C vein extends several hundred feet further to the southwest where it intersects the AB vein, forming a larger continuous mineralized zone as reported in C11 and C13.

The next two drill holes are targeted to interest the C and AB veins further updip and downdip from C11 to test the continuity of this larger mineralization zone around C11.
