INCO TO DRILL CIMADORO - Marino Specogna, director, Doromin Resources Ltd., reports

INCO LTD, plans to drill the Cimadoro property located 3½ km west of Sandspit, Queen Charlotte Islands, B.C.

Inco can earn a 67% interest by making staged payments totalling \$250,000 and spending \$1,500,000 over four years, after which time a joint venture will be formed.

Inco will drill test a barite anomaly located through geological mapping and coincident geophysical anomaly located on the east grid and further drill the main showings. The program is expected to start early in the new year, weather permitting, and should be completed by May/93. The barite anomaly is delineated for 1,500 meters and ranges in width from 90 to 300 meters. Barite is a gold indicator mineral typical of sedimentary exhalative deposits. The geophysical anomalies are coincident with the barite anomaly and extend for over 1,200 meters and range in width from 50 to 300 meters SW of the main showings.

Geological mapping has outlined Permian sedimentary stratigraphy over 14.5 km. The Permian sediments, consisting of cherts and argillites, host the Cimadoro showings, various geochemical anomalies and four multi-line airborne electromagnetic anomalies.

Four mineral occurrences outside of the Cimadoro showings were re-located, mapped and sampled. The copper showings returned values ranging from 0.37% to over 10% copper, 3.9% lead, 9.5% zinc across 2.8 meters and 0.006 oz.gold/ton, 3.03 oz.silver/ton, 0.44% copper, 3.1% lead and 10.9% zinc across 2.95 meters.
