

WINSLOW GOLD CORP. (WGC-V)

HIGH GRADE GOLD DISCOVERED - Hugh G. Ross, president, reports Winslow Gold Corp. and its 50/50 joint venture partner Gentry Resources Ltd. have completed the 1992 exploration program on the Engineer Mine property. The ground, which encompasses Crown granted claims of the old Engineer mine and surrounding modified grid claims, is on the east shore of Tagish Lake 35 km west of Atlin, B.C. Up until 1952, a total of 18,420 tons were milled giving 19,637 ounces of gold. The companies have agreed for Ampex Mining to conduct a \$125,000 exploration program. Under the terms, Ampex funded the program to receive a portion of any high grade ore mined. The work began with exploring the 100, 200 and 500-foot mine levels. A new portal was constructed at the 500-foot crosscut and about 1,200

feet of drift was rehabilitated. Exploration at the intersection of the Engineer vein and the 500-foot level crosscut tunnel was completed. An assay of vein material next to some high grade returned 0.9 oz.gold/ton. About 50 feet from the 500-foot/Engineer vein intersection, several small but rich high grade nodules were discovered containing dendritic gold. One sample the size of a small football graded 732 oz.gold/ton. Ampex believes the potential for high grade pockets and nodules exists within the 500 and upper mine levels.

The 1993 program will continue with more drilling and blasting. An attempt will be made to determine a grade of ore that could support a small mining operation. Winslow has acquired a jaw crusher and stamp mill in anticipation. A surface exploration program consisting of geochemical and geophysical survey will also be conducted.
