OMEGA GOLD CORP. (OGC-V)

TWO POLYMETALLIC DISCOVERIES REPORTED - Nelson Baker, director, reports Omega Gold Corp. has identified two new poly-metallic mineral discoveries on the 100%-owned Kit property located in the Cranbrook area of southern B.C.

On the same stratigraphic horizon and three km south of the Kootenay King mine, a stratiform lead/zinc massive sulphide deposit, SCC Resources Inc. has traced a strong lead/zinc soil geochemical anomaly 100 by 200 meters in size. The other discovery, a stockwork vein system carrying anomalous values of gold, silver, lead and copper was located along a new road cut some 2.5 km northeast of the lead/zinc anomaly on a separate structure. Selected samples from a three-meter wide vein system assayed 3% copper, 60.37% lead, 11.04

oz.silver/ton and 0.2 oz.gold/ton.

A program of detailed mapping, sampling and diamond drilling is planned for this spring. SCC has an option to earn a 50% interest in the Kit property by spending \$250,000 on exploration over two years. (SEE GCNL No.11, 16Jan92; P.2 FOR OTHER PROJECT INFORMATION)
