MYRA FALLS DRILL RESULTS - Bruce McKnight, vice president, reports Westmin Resources Ltd. has received assay results from a surface drill discovery at the Myra Falls mining operation, west of Campbell River, Vancouver Island, B.C. The upper intersection appears to correlate with the top of the H-W Rhyolite and the lower zone with the bottom of the H-W stratigraphy.
