FURTHER DRILLING FOR AGASSIZ-WEAVER - International
MASSIVE SULPHIDE ZONES Curator Resources
has reported

Minnova Inc. is planning a minimum of 16,000 feet of diamond drilling on the Seneca portion of the Agassiz-Weaver property, near Chilliwack, B.C., 100 km east of Vancouver, B.C. Drilling will start mid March, 1992 to delimit extent of the Fleetwood Zone which now has a 2,150 ft. strike length. It is believed that the Fleetwood Zone and the Vent Zone, which occurs about 2,600 feet to the southeast, are part of the same mineralizing event. The area between the two zones has not been tested and is considered to be highly prospective. Minnova, Inc. can earn 60% by spending \$2,100,000 on exploration and making property payments of \$300,000 by the end of 1998. (SEE SAME EXPLORATION RESULTS IN GCNL NO. 215, P. 3, NOV. 7, 1991).
