JORDEX RESOURCES INC. (JDX-V)

HIGHEST GRADE RESULTS YET FROM HUSHAMU - In the current
drill program

by Jordex Resources on the copper property near Port
Hardy, Vancouver Island, B.C. Hole No. EC206 has
intersected 512 ft. of ore grading 0.30% copper and
0.016 opt gold. The intersection, 290 vertical feet
from surface, included 177 ft. of 0.40% copper and 0.024
opt gold and is the highest grade mineralization ever
encountered on the Hushamu. The location of Hole EC206
is significant in that it is situated just south of Hole
EC200 where the company received earlier high grade
results. This suggests the development, in the SW area,
of a high grade zone within the Hushamu mineral resource.

Results from the remaining three holes in current
program will be announced shortly. In addition the
company has retained Steffen, Robertson & Kirsten, an
independent engineering firm, to update the reserve
estimate which will be completed by 29Feb91 before the
