is a promising property, near twelve formerly producing gold, silver and copper mines.

The Silver Box property was acquired 100% in 1989. The area of interest is a 400ft. long, 100 ft. width. Mineralization was found by trenching and exploration in 1990-91. These mineral deposits consist of gold and silver with lead and zinc. Assays of the samples returned values as high as 1.57 oz/ton gold over a 14 ft. width and 97.37 oz/ton silver over a 5 ft. width.

The 1992 program is planned to outline the length and width of this known mineralized zone. This program

will consist of additional trenching, sampling, and detailed geological mapping. Key Largo will also investigate a strong arsenic geochem anomaly 3,000 ft. to the north west of the mineralized zone.
