CHAPLEAU RESOURCES LTD. (CHI-V)

TWO EXPLORATION PROGRAMS - Chapleau Resources Ltd. has reported on the Arc project, Crawford Bay B.C., access, trenching and drill pad preparation are underway and drilling will begin by July 5/92. The primary target is a lead, zinc, copper, silver outcrop. Geochemical soil samples have traced the showing over 900 feet on surface with high assays of 2% lead, 6% zinc, 0.49% copper and 10 oz. silver/t.

On the Shasta project also Crawford Bay, B.C. diamond drill hole SH92-3 averaged 0.93% copper, 4.35 lead, 4.41% zinc and 4.4 ounces per ton silver over 7.55 feet. Diamond Drill hole SH92-1 intersected 3.28 feet containing 0.55% copper, 1.40% lead, 0.93% zinc and 5.59 ounces silver per ton. Geological mapping is ongoing and will be followed by further geophysics and drilling.
