Westmin Resources has reported assay results from two holes recently drilled in the Battle/Gap areas, of the mine located 100 km southwest of Campbell River, Vancouver Island, B.C.

Hole No. 14-730, which apparently intersected a deeper portion of the Battle Zone, returned assays lower than visually estimated but still very good and important from the prospective of extending Battle tonnage to the south. Hole No. 15-462 has intersected very high grade ore which is thought to be a southern and western extension of the Gap Zone. The hole was drilled off section to the West and at the ore intersection point was 40 metres west of the section. Battle/Gap drilling continues with four machines.
