DOROMIN RESOURCES LTD. (DOI-V) HIGH GRADE COPPER FOUND ON SURFACE - Marino Specogna, director, Doromin Resources Ltd., reports exploration outlined an area of high grade copper surface mineralization on recently staked ground on northern Vancouver Island. The surface showing outcrops for at least 10 metres. An area several hundred metres to the south of the original discovery yielded sulphide-rich float which returned significant base metal results. The float is abundant and appears to originate nearby. The results returned were: 0.012 oz. platinum/t, 0.087% cobalt, 0.420% nickel, 0.23% copper, 0.18 oz. silver/t and 0.006 oz. gold/t; palladium was not assayed for. The results were equivalent to 0.23 oz. gold/t. The results are significant as higher grade sections can be expected to be found within the host formation. Geological fieldwork of the total claim as well as sampling of the extensive original sphalerite, galena-rich showing are underway.
