SUSTUT DRILLING IN PROGRESS - George Slightham, president, Beauchamps Exploration Inc., reports drilling has begun at the Sustut project, jointly held with Skeena Resources Ltd., and located 60 km south of the Kemess area about 190 km north of Smithers, B.C. An initial 5-6 hole diamond drill program is testing both the Day Occurrence, where previous drilling by Falconbridge returned 0.67% copper and 0.027 oz. gold/ton over 197 feet, and the Porcupine zone which appears to be a massive sulphide zone which has selected surface grab samples running from 1 to 5 grams/ton gold and 1.25% to 5.40% copper.

This project has been a 50/50 joint venture, but under the terms of a revised agreement Beauchamps may earn a 75% interest in the project by spending a further \$200,000 on exploration by 31Dec93. (SEE GCNL No.114, 12Jun92, P.3 FOR PREVIOUS PROJECT INFORMATION)
