Beauchamps Exploration Inc. announces that further drilling has started on the Sustut Project. The property is jointly held with Skeena Resources Ltd. and is situated 30 miles south of the Kemess porphyry copper deposit, 160 miles north of Smithers, B.C.

This phase of drilling will focus on evaluating the

extent of the porphyry mineralization on the 'Day' occurrence previously drilled this summer. DDH 92-1 yielded the results listed below.

A series of step-out holes to the east of the discovery hole has begun. These holes will test the geophysical anomaly and coincident copper/gold/silver-geochemical anomalies extending for a distance of 3,000 feet in that direction.

Skeena Resources Ltd. has provided the necessary funds for this second phase of drilling.

Significant results over a minimum 5-foot interval are in table.

No further work is planned on this zone at this time, although the source of the high grade (5-6% copper) boulders downslope has not been found.
