BARKHOR RESOURCES INC. (BHO-V)

ASSAYS AWAITED - Barkhor Resources president, Gerry R.

Newcoman has reported diamond drilling the Shasta claims, two miles south of the Blue Bell mine, Slocan area, B.C. is continuing on hole No. 4.

DDH SH-1 cut 5 feet of high grade lead, zinc, silver, copper, and entered a fault at 90 feet. DDH SH-3 cut 4 feet of good grade ore, and entered an old adit at 50 feet and at a depths of 800-1,000 feet. These intersections are in bed rock and are similar in structure that intersect around the Blue Bell mine.

The Blue Bell mine produced 4,700,000 tons of 6.5% lead, 8.2% zinc, ranging in widths of 5 feet to 100 feet.

On the Arc claims, Slocan, B.C. line cutting is completed and geophysics to be completed in late June with diamond drilling to follow.
