BARKHOR RESOURCES INC. (BHO-V) POLYMETALLIC HIGH GRADE INTERSECTED - William Daly, president, reports Chapleau Resources Ltd. has intersected about five feet of high grade lead/zinc/silver/copper in diamond drill

hole SH-1 on the Shasta claims, Crawford Bay, southeast B.C. Chapleau can earn a 50% interest from Barkhor Resources Inc. by issuing 100,000 shares and spending \$100,000 on exploration. Hole SH-2 cut about four feet of good grade ore which terminated in a fault structure at about 50 feet. Hole SH-3 entered an old adit at about 50 feet and was discontinued. Hole SH-4 is currently being drilled and has a target depth of 800 -I,000 feet. The intersections from hole SH-1 and 2 are being split and sent for assay. The ore-grade similar intersections appear in structure to intersections from the Blue Bell mine about two miles north, which produced 4,700,000 tons averaging 6.5% lead and 8.2% zinc in widths from 5-100 feet.
