MORE BATTLE ZONE ASSAYS - Bruce McKnight, vice president,
corporate affairs, reports

Westmin Resources has received assays for hole 14-729,
drilled on the Battle zone, part of the Myra Falls mine
west of Campbell River, Vancouver Island, B.C. The
highest intersection is similar in style to the Gap
zone, the lowest one is Battle zone and the intermediate
intersection is mineralogically similar to, but
stratigraphically higher than, the Battle zone. The
hole is still advancing. Management views the above
results as encouraging as they indicate the Battle zone
