MASSIVE SULPHIDE INTERSECTION - Michael D. McInnis, president Int'l Curator, re-

ports Minnova Inc. intersected high grade massive sulphides over a drilled thickness of 3.2 m in hole S-33 on the Seneca property, 100 km east of Vancouver, B.C.

Hole S-33 occurs about 400 metres south of the Fleetwood Zone, which Minnova has been testing on 200-metre centres. It is not clear whether the massive sulphide intercept in hole S-33 is a southerly extension of the Fleetwood Zone. Drilling will continue on wide spaced intervals. Minnova optioned the property in 1990 and can earn a 60% by spending \$2,100,000 by 1998.
