TIMMINS NICKEL INC. (TMH-V)

THREE PROJECTS REVIEWED - Timmins Nickel has reported an intersection of 47 feet of

1.14% nickel at the Langmuir North Zone, 400 feet to the north of the previously outlined zone, which has been reported at 500,000 tons of 1.2% nickel. Further drilling of this target is plannad in the spring.

Timmins Nickel and HABSBURG RESOURCES LTD. (HAB-V) also reported recent diamond drilling at their Dome Mountain project, 20 miles east of Smithers, B.C. has added 80,000 tons of one in the drill-indicated possible category at a cut grade of 0.41 opt gold in an area in front of the 1285-portal to the east of the previously outlined Boulder Zone. The zone remains open to the east and to depth. A major surface exploration program is planned during the summer.

Drifting along ore will start in about one month.

Further underground drilling will take place at that time and ore reserves will then be re-calculated. On a preliminary basis, the estimated life of the mine has been increased to 6 years at current operating rates of 5,000 to 6,000 tons per month.
