CATHEDRAL GOLD CORPORATION (CAT-I)

At the 100% owned Takla Rainbow property in the Quesnellia Terrane, 30 miles west of Manson Creek, 110 miles northwest of Smithers, B.C. reserves are 321,000 tons grading 0.25 oz. gold/t. Further exploration work on this project will likely await a return to more normal and higher gold prices.

Cathedral holds a 50% interest in the Bronson Creek property which lies between Johnny Mountain mine of Skyline and the Gulf International Inel property. The strong structural zone named the Bronson trend extends from the 100,000 oz. gold per year Snip mine, southeast across the Bronson Creek property. Previous intersections include 15 feet grading 0.456 oz. gold per ton.

Porcher Island mine is 100% owned and locate 25 miles south of Prince Rupert, B.C. with reserves of 1,500,000 tons grading 0.20 oz. gold/t, in a series of

veins. Renewed exploration or possible farmout is likely to await better gold markets.
