GREEN VALLEY MINE INCORPORATION (GVY-V)

LAKWOOD MINING CO. LTD. (LKW-V)

ASSAYS STILL AWAITED - Green Valley Mine Incorporation  
50% and Lakewood Mining Co. Ltd.

50% director Doreen Boitard has reported diamond  
drilling on the Wood Claims 5 km south of Afton and 12  
km South West of Kamloops, B.C., is continuing. (SEE  
MAP OVERLEAF P.1, GCNL NO.92, MAY 12/92).

The D.D.H. No.92-5 is now in progress and at the  
depth of 650 feet as of 2 pm, Monday, May 18th. The  
drilling encountered a large fault zone at 460 feet, the  
formation encountered below is the host of significant  
disseminated native copper mineralization within a  
heavily altered zone. The D.D.H. No.92-5 contains a  
greater degree of visual mineralization than the D.D.H  
No.92-2 (located 60 meters west).

The D.D.H. No.92-3 located approximately 850 meters  
north of the D.D.H. No.92-5 intersected similar  
formation. The drilling program will continue, to  
delineate the zone of mineralization. Assays are  
pending.

Lakewood Mining has reached a verbal agreement for  
a private placement of \$508,100 for the purchase of  
564,555 units at 90¢ each. Units of one share and one  
warrant are exercisable at 90¢ in year one and at \$1.03  
in year two. Subject to Vancouver Stock Exchange  
approvals.
