LA ROCK MINING CORP. (LAR-V)

EARLY DRILLING PLANNED - Martial Levasseur, president FOR MASSIVE SULPHIDE ZONE of La Rock Mining Corp. has reported strong electromagnetic responses are being obtained over a length of 300 m extending from the high grade massive sulphide Tedi Pit, on the 100% owned property at Brandywine, 30 miles north of Squamish, B.C. Sampling by P. Fox, P. Eng. in the Tedi Pit assayed 0.047 oz.gold/t, 4.30 oz. silver/t, 10.9% lead, 14.98% zinc and 1.71% copper over 16 feet.

The deep penetrating pulse electromagnetic survey has detected four parallel conductors which appear to form a fold structure that is open along both limbs to the south. Prospecting in the area of the strong conductor found base-metal sulphide float. The geophysical work is expected to be 50% completed by 15May92. Diamond drilling will start shortly. The company is negotiating financing for a major diamond drill program. (SEE GCNL NO. 50, P. 2, 11MAR92).
