ration program at the Merry

Widow Mine, in the Port Hardy/Port McHeill area, north Vancouver Island, B.C. The program was supervised by J.D. Graham, a mining and geological engineer. Initial results indicate that the program has proved up a tonnage which can be shipped to a local concentrator.

The program included 2,700 feet drilled in 84 The 750 bench and Raven zones were also trenched. Large samples were collected from the 750 and 700 benches. These samples will be used for gold, silver and copper recovery tests. Representatives of two major mining houses toured the property during the program.

At the Raven zone, a deep cover of broken rock was encountered. As a result, the excavation required to expose the old Raven pit was not completed. This zone will be re-examined at a later date. The remainder of the program confirmed the existence of ore-grade mineralization.
