VISIBLE GOLD FOUND ON THREE LEVELS - J.Frank Callaghan,
president, reports

Wayside Gold Mines 50% and Brigadier Resources 50% have observed visible gold on the 7th, 8th and 9th levels of the Wayside gold mine at Goldbridge, B.C. Reopening of the No.5 portal and the dewatering of the Wayside mine to the 9th level is now complete. Access to the No.9 level has not been accessed since a surface fire in 1953.

The tunnels and crosscuts are all in excellent condition and the vein is in excess of the mining width of five feet and strikes for 500 feet. Random grab samples from the vein on No.5 level assayed 0.58 oz.gold/ton; No.7 level assay was 0.67 oz.gold/ton and 1.46 oz.gold/ton; and a No.8 level sample returned 2.29 oz.gold/ton.

Sampson Engineering has carried out a program of channel sampling of which 110 samples have been sent for assay. Some further sampling from the stope pillars and the raise between the 8th and 9th levels is underway. Plans for proposed underground drilling are being finalized. Two underground drills will be used and should start Nov.16. The underground drill program is to verify surface drilling which, under the 9th level, hole 80S-10 intersected 15 feet of 1.76 oz.gold/ton of which 10 feet returned 2.63 oz.gold/ton on the main vein. DDH 87-1 by Chevron cut 5.23 feet of 1.84 oz. gold/ton on the Notman vein. (SEE GCNL No.186, 25Sep92, P.2 FOR PREVIOUS PROJECT INFORMATION)
