UPDATED FISH LAKE RESERVE ESTIMATE - Robert G. Hunter,
chairman, Taseko

Mines Ltd., presents an updated preliminary reserve estimate for the Fish Lake copper/gold deposit located 150 miles southwest of Williams Lake, B.C. See table above. The reserve calculation parameters were: 120 drill holes on 330-foot centres, 75-meter radii polygons, specific gravity 2.70 grams per cubic centimeter, 20-meter bench composites and high grade gold assays cut to 1.0 grams/tonne. Mr. Hunter states Fish Lake is Canada's largest undeveloped bulk tonnage metal resource.
