LANG BAY RESOURCES LTD. (LNB-V)

ADDITIONAL PAPER TEST PLANNED - Lang Bay Resources Ltd. president Lauch F. Farris has reported Fletcher Challenge Canada has confirmed its decision to carry out an extended paper mill production trail using 60 tonnes of Lang Bay Kaolin. The trial is expected to take two or three days to complete and will be carried out at Fletcher Challenge's Elk Falls Pulp and Paper Division at Campbell River, B.C.

Lang Bay Resources will mine a 2,000-tonne bulk sample for processing in a pilot mill to produce 500 tonnes of Lang Bay's kaolin product - LBK-60 from its 100%-owned kaolin property located about 60 miles northwest of Vancouver, near Powell River, B.C. Sixty tonnes of this will be sent to Elk Falls and the balance is expected to be used for other paper mill trials in the Pacific Northwest. All environmental permits have been issued. To finance the above bulk sample and pilot mill, the company plans to carry out a \$1,000,000 financing. (SEE GCNL No.110, 8Jun92, P.1 FOR MORE DATA)
