La Rock Mining Corp. continues to drill to build tonnage in the more confined area known as the Tedi Pit on the property 70 km north of Vancouver, B.C. This area is 200 ft. by 300 ft. within the larger 700 ft. by 1,000 ft. grid previously announced. Drill holes 1 through 7, and 16 through 21, and current holes 32 through 41 have been drilled within this smaller grid to expand both the 75,000 tons proven and 370,000 tons probable reserves reported by Robert L. Roscoe P. Eng. in his 1974 Progress Report to Tedi Resources Ltd.

The values per ton represent the Gross Value per ton at current spot prices in Canadian dollars.

It is estimated each vertical foot of mineralization per drill hole adds 325 tons of ore reserve. Assays from drill holes 36, 37, 38 will be available in the week of Oct. 5/92.
