Drilling continues of La Rock's Brandy Wine project 25 miles north of Squamish, B.C. The company's goal for the 1992 drilling season of 1,000,000 plus tons of open pitable mineral reserves from \$40.00 to \$60.00 per ton Cdn. is in sight with the completion of holes 36 through 43.
