Resources have completed installation of 90 feet of 10 feet diameter metal culvert under the Lillooet-Goldbridge highway, 4 km east of Goldbridge, B.C. Rehabilitation of the No. 5 portal at the 50/50 owned Wayside mine at the same locations is also complete. The work program was the joint effort of the B.C. Ministry of Transportation and Highways, Wayside Gold Mines and Brigadier Resources.

Goldbridge is near the Bralorne and Pioneer gold mining camps.

Now that access has been achieved through the No. 5 portal, Phase 2 of the companies' work program is now well under way and consists of dewatering the old workings to No. 9 level which has not been accessed since the great fire of 1953. The estimated time for completing the dewatering is Oct.20/92.

The companies note that J.P. Elwell, P.Eng., in his 2Nov71 report, stated the mine had been dewatered to a point just below the No. 8 level. Mr. Elwell commented the vein was well exposed on the No. 8 level to the south. The vein varied from 2 ft. to more than 6 ft. in width consisting of crushed white quartz with a narrow gouge seam on the hanging wall. The sections had been stoped to the No. 7 level, but chip samples were taken across various sections of the vein which had been left as stope pillars. Mr. Elwell noted free gold in several pieces of vein quartz from this level. The samples and assays, given below, are from the aforementioned report: SAMPLE GOLD WIDTH

Mr. Elwell concluded the examination and sampling of the 8th level, while insufficient to calculate the overall mineral value of the vein at this level does tend to confirm the previous reports of improvement of the vein structure and gold values to SE and to depth.

The companies are confident the current program will substantiate previous surface drilling which, under the 9th level, intersected 15 feet of 1.76 ounces of gold per ton on the main vein and 5.23 feet of 1.84 ounces of gold per ton on the Notman vein.

The companies will not proceed with the acquisition of shares by way of an issuers bid.
