property located six km west of the terminus of the Granduc mining road, about 38 km north of Stewart. B.C.

A geological interpretation of the drill logs indicates the 1992 drilling intersected the outer portion of a pyritic halo such as typically surrounds a porphyry deposit. The pervasive quartz/calcite veining and high pyrite content, as observed in the drill core are earmarks of a halo, with the best copper values to be found within the halo.

Holes 92-4 and 5 were collared a few hundred meters southeast of the first three holes to test a gold target, but did not encounter significant mineralization. The 1992 drill program was terminated during casing of hole 92-6 due to a breakdown of the rig. Teuton plans to follow up with another program in 1993 as soon as weather permits.
