The first hole, L92-6, which was drilled to the NW for 151 metres at -47° , cut two bedded sulphide zones from 88.8 to 90.3 m and from 95.0 to 96.2 m. The sulphide horizons have a banded texture which is parallel to the bedding in the adjacent meta- sediments. The sulphide content of the mineral beds ranges from 30% to 80%, mainly sphlalerite, pyrite and rare galena.

The upper sulphide horizon has a weighted average grade of 7.10% zinc, 0.58 oz. silver/t, 0.02% lead, and 0.03% cadmium over 1.5 metres. This interval includes a 90 centimetre zone of 8.34% zinc, 0.74 oz. silver/t, 0.08% lead and 0.03% cadmium.

The second hole is drilling to test down dip of the mineralized horizons found in the first hole.

A drilling program in 1990 confirmed the presence of the two bedded sphalerite (zinc) horizons occurring over a stratigraphic interval of 20 metres. Hole L90-1 intersected both the upper zone, which averaged 4.75% zinc from 74 metres to 81 metres with a 2.6 metre interval of 10.2% zinc, and the lower zone which averaged 2.49% zinc from 112 metres to 117 metres. Two of three step out holes intersected the lower zone which assayed 5.5 metres at 3.6% and 8.6 metres at 2.3% zinc.

Consolidated Ramrod owns 27 of the claims and has an option to earn a 50% interest in the 13 other claims from <u>LEGION RESOURCES LTD.</u> (LGN-V) by spending a total of \$500,000 on exploration on the Leg Property by Oct. 31/92. Ramrod has spent \$250,000 to date.
