GOLD PRODUCTION TEST PROCEEDING - G.L.Garratt, secretary, reports Eastfield Res-

ources Ltd. is mobilizing crews and equipment to its Spanish Mountain property, located 65 km northeast of Williams Lake. B.C., to begin preparatory work for a small-scale gold production test. Work will include establishing water supply, drainage systems, settling ponds and the plant site. A gold recovery plant will then be moved on site and material processing will start. This initial program is expected to be completed in one or two weeks at which time the gold recovery system should begin operation. The plant will be operated until freeze-up which is expected to be in late November.

It is anticipated that by the end of October an estimate of cash flow to the company from this operation wil be established and the potential for expanding high-grade mineable reserves will be determined. The work will be undertaken by Renoble Holdings Ltd., which holds a mining lease from Eastfield. Net revenue from production will be shared equally between the companies.
