Richard George Whatley, president of Alpha Gold has reported on the diamond drilling program at the Lustdust property, 36 km NW of Takla Landing, 150 km northwest of Fort St. James, B.C. (SEE GCNL NO. 18, P.2, Jan.27, 1992, for acquisition terms on a 100% working interest) DDH 92-20 is 110 feet west of DDH 92-15. The results are shown in the table above.

Additional diamond drill holes have intersected massive sulphides with grades that appear similar to the above. The geological mapping, geophysical study, and diamond drilling continues.
