SILVER POND EXPLORATION COMPLETED - Bevan Anderson, director, reports

Even Resources Ltd. has completed a \$75,000 exploration program on the Silver Pond Property located in the Toodoggone area of north-central B.C., about four km northwest of the Sturdee airstrip. The property is accessible by road in the summer.

Even has an option to earn a 100% interest in the 128 claims covering 3,200 acres by making payments totalling \$270,000 and spending \$225,000 on exploration by 31Dec94, subject to a 2% net smelter return royalty. The exploration program included surveying the boundary with the adjoining Cheni Gold Mines Ltd. Lawyers property, detailed prospecting, remapping of alteration zones and trenching in overburden and weathered rock.

At least 12 mineralized quartz zones not reported in previous work were identified in overburden within an area measuring 300 metres by 1,500 metres. Four of these were trenched down to weathered vein material in place and one has an indicated width of 12 to 14 feet. Visually the veins resemble the "A" type vein at the nearby Baker mine. Evaluation of the zones will depend on the results of a number of samples now being assayed, however, management is confident that drill targets will be established for a program next spring.

The company will shortly be announcing the work program on its Inca de Oro project, located in the Province of Chanaral, Chile. (SEE GCNL No.161, 20Aug92, P.5 FOR OTHER PROJECT INFORMATION).
