## GOLD GIANT MINERALS INC. (GNR-V)

PHASE I SNOBALL DRILLING COMPLETED - Donald Sheldon, president, reports Gold Giant Minerals Inc. has been informed HEMLO GOLD MINES\_INC. (HEM-V,T,M) has completed the Phase I drilling program, on the Snoball project located about 55 km north of Corona's Eskay Creek deposits in northwest B.C. A total of 1,095 meters in 10 drill holes tested a variety of targets.

The drilling intersected several intervals of suplhide-rich (2-40%) silicified siltstones for up to 67 meters within Lower-Middle Jurassic-age Eskay Creek Facies sediments. Sulphides consist of semi-massive to disseminated pyrrhotite and pyrite with occasional chalcopyrite. Anomalous gold values have been encountered over substantial widths. Only partial assays have been received for four of the 10 holes drilled to date; other assays are pending.

The Phase II drill program, comprising about 600 meters, is expected to start within a week and will further test the sulphide-bearing units. Gold Giant has the right to fund \$3,000,000 in exploration over the next five years to earn a 50% interest in the property. (SEE GCNL No.166, 27Aug92, P.1 FOR OTHER PROJECT DATA).
