ROAD WORK & TRENCHING TO START - Yukon Revenue Mines has received governmental permission to build an access road and do backhoe trenching on the recently optioned claims 30 km south-east of Nelson, B.C. Work will begin in a few days. An inspection of many of the trenches and dumps was made last week and it is clear that there are five or more stratiform deposits stacked in proximity to each other. The deposits are each different from the others, varying from copper-siderite, to zinc-lead, to lead-copper breccias. The mineralized area is overburden covered but a large number of hand dug pits and trenches from the period 1915 to 1928 have been opened so that the mineralization is exposed again. Surface sphalerite has been removed by weathering but relatively fresh material is present on the dump at the caved mine portal.

A brief inspection was made of a series of copper bearing breccias two kilometres to the south, on strike, and in the same stratigraphic horizon. These are covered by the claim group as well.
