LA ROCK MINING CORP. (LAR-V)
MORE BRANDYWINE DRILL RESULTS - Robert E. Lee, president,
reports La Rock Mining
Corp. has received further assays from the Brandywine gold property
located about 40 km north of Squamish, B.C. The company has a 100%

interest, subject to a 0.5% net smelter return royalty. Diamond drill hole MS NO.9 returned 20 feet grading 0.047 oz.gold/ton from 103 - 123 feet and 6.03 oz.silver/ton. A five-foot section ran 23.67 oz.silver/ton.

Readily visible native gold that may constitute a material positive change, has been encountered in DP NO.4, in the 1,000-foot step-out along the trend of the quartz-sericite schist towards Dave's Pond. The hole intersected a well-mineralized section with base metals and specks of native visible gold. This intersection is a new discovery for La Rock in the Brandywine Creek gold camp, which hosted the Northair Gold Mine in the 1970's. Hole DP NO.3 intersected a geologically interpreted volcanic vent which may control the precious metal mineralization. Both DP NO.3 and DP NO.4 have been prepared and sent out for gold and silver assays. (SEE GCNL NO.143, 27Jul93, P.3 FOR PREVIOUS PROJECT INFORMATION)
