ENCOURAGING DRILLING CONTINUES - Dr. Robert E. Lee, president, La Rock Mining Corp., has

reported the next three holes have cut what appears to be the same favourable mineralized zone as that cut in hole No. DP-4. The company has now drilled No.DP-4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 on the Dave's Pond zone which is located 1,000 feet to the northeast of the Main zone. (SEE ZONE LOCATION MAP OVERLEAF PAGE 2, NO. 153, AUG. 11, 1993 and accompaning story on page one) Some detail from the assays from hole DP No.4 are shown in the table above. The Dave's Pond area is on the Brandywine property located about 40 km north of Squamish, B.C. The company has a 100% interest subject to a 0.5% NSR.

Hole DP No.4 penetrated the flat-lying quartz-sericite schist horizon at a -45° angle with massive sulphides and visible gold. More recent holes suggest a synform structure dipping at minus 20 degrees, along a east northeast strike, 75 to 80 degree azimith. The drill target was suggested by geological mapping and a soil sample anomaly located by survey work in 1989 when Placer Dome carried out an examination of the property. The anomalous areas has a 2-km strike length and returned silver reading of 1,300 to 1,700 parts per million with a high of 13,000 parts silver per million. As well there were elevated gold readings in the anomalous areas in the 1,000 parts per billion range with a high of 4,400 parts gold per billion.

Drilling is continuing on No.9 and No.10 with additional assays expected in the next week. Additional funding to continue drilling has been negotiated.
