PORPHYRY COPPER GOLD ASSAYS REPORTED - Romulus Resources

has reported diamond drill holes 93-01 and 93-02 have intersected stockwork hosted gold-copper mineralization near surface and over substantial intervals on the Brenda Zone of the Pine property in the Kemess gold copper district 200 kn NW of Prince George, central B. C. The results confirm the presence of a geological environment typical of porphyry bulk tonnage deposits. Assay results are summarized as follows:

These indicate yet another copper-gold-rich porphyry system within the Kemess district. The company expects to start work on the Pine Zone by Aug. 25, 1993, where 1992 drilling demonstrated a gold copper porphyry system.

Romulus' management team is the same group that has developed other large tonnage gold-copper porphyry deposits, specifically Mt. Milligan and El Condor Resources Ltd.'s Kemess South deposit.
