HAS RESUMED PRODUCTION International Skyline Gold Corp.,

reports mining of the Johnny Mountain Mine Stonehouse deposit in northwest B.C. began 20Aug93. The initial target is 20,000 tons grading 0.508 ounces of recoverable gold per ton to be mined and delivered to the mill over the next 90 days, by the end of November 1993.

The mill is scheduled to resume operations on 16Sept93 and operate for about 60 days and is forecast to produce some 10,000 ounces of gold at a cost of US \$233 per ounce. The 1993 underground exploration program for new reserves has been completed with 4,037 feet of drilling being undertaken. Assay results of drill core sampled to date will be combined with additional results not yet received to compile a new mineral inventory. Several high grade intersections have been identified which will result in some of the previously reported geological reserves being reclassified as mineable reserves and new reserves are being added to the geological inventory.

Exploration results have also identified a possible new zone of mineralization that will require additional drilling for interpretation.

Surface drilling of the Zephrin and 16 zones is underway with this phase of the exploration program expected to be completed in early September. A trenching and sampling program already completed on the Zephrin has identified an area measuring 70 by 40 feet containing anomalous ore grade material.
