VISIBLE GOLD ENCOUNTERED AT SB PROJECT - Tenajon Resources Corp. and 50/50

joint venture partner Westmin Resources Ltd. report underground exploration is continuing on the SB project, located 30 km by road. north of Stewart, B.C. To date, 104 metres of raising has been completed on the Kansas/W. Kansas zone and visible gold mineralization has been intersected in the access raise and 895-meter elevation sublevel drifts. Clusters of fine-grained native gold grains occur in several related types of narrow veinlets. The narrow veinlets form a swarm trending roughly north-south and diping subvertically. although within the swarm veinlets occur many orientations. The width of the swarm of veinlets containing visible gold is at least four meters, but its westward limit is at present undefined.

Gold mineralization from the raise and sublevel are being stockpiled and will be milled at Westmin Resources' Premier Mill near Stewart at or before the end of the development program. From August 4 when mineralization was first encountered, to August 16 a total of 365 tons were stockpiled. Representative sampling of gold mineralization in this mode of occurrence is extremely difficult and samples, collected by a geologist from broken muck and drift walls, have ranged from 0.013 to 1.864 oz.gold/ton to give an average gold grade of 0.128 oz.gold/ton for the stockpiled tonnage.

Development of the access raise is continuing and a second sublevel will be established at an elevation of 917 meters. Once both sublevels are established, 168 metres of subdrifting and raising will be carried out within the zone. In addition, 1,900 metres of underground definition diamond drilling will be implemented from the new workings. Westmin is operator.
