GOOD GOLD AT MIDNIGHT - Karl Rollke, president, Consolidated Ramrod Gold Corp., has reported results of a recent drilling program conducted on its 100%-optioned Midnight gold property located near Rossland, B.C. southwest of the Le Roi Mine which produced 2,500,000 ounces of gold during its operation. Exploration drilling showed strong gold mineralization in a serpentine zone. This zone suggests a viable bulk mineable target. Ramrod has carried out magnetometer surveys which have outlined an anomaly that correlates with outcrops containing pyrrhotite and chalcopyrite, two minerals associated with gold mineralization in the area. Holes S-93-1, 2 and 3 all drilled from the same set-up all encountered strong gold values as follows:

High grade gold averaging 0.445 oz. gold/ton over 15 feet has been observed from channel samples taken at the adit level. Further sampling and drilling will be undertaken to trace this high grade gold bearing zone. The drill rig has been moved to the northeast of the Serpentine Zone. Drilling will be conducted to test a magnetic anomaly and to prove a solid continuation of the zone.

In addition to the Midnight project, Ramrod is currently drilling at Damoti Lake in the Northwest Territories, Bru Lovie in Nevada, Matthews and Lead Hill in Washington State and Fors/Vine in B.C. The company is also awaiting a permit for rehabilitating the 900-foot level at its recently announced joint venture with Atlanta Gold near Boise, Idaho and will start an aggressive drill program on its Railroad Property on the Carlin Trend in Nevada in early January.
