FINAL 1993 ASSAYS IN FOR - John A. Greig, president, Redfern TULSEQUAH CHIEF/BIG BULL Resources Ltd., presents the final drill hole assays for the 100%-owned Tulsequah Chief and nearby Big Bull projects located about 60 miles south of Adlin, northern B.C. SEE TABLE OF ASSAYS AND MAPS OVERLEAF P.1. All drill holes with intersections of greater than \$45ton NSR value are reported. Assay results for four of the Big Bull holes indicated by asterisks have been upgraded from preliminary assays released September 28 and reported in GCNL NO.187, 29Sept93, P.1. Drilling has confirmed the Big Bull is a very large mineralized system, at least 4,000 feet in strike length and open in all directions. A comparison with the Tulsequah Chief deposit shows there is easily room for a Tulsequah-size ore body to occur within the wide spacing of the 1993 drill pattern. The Tulsequah Chief program, because it was primarily infill drilling, was not expected to increase reserves, however, drilling has increased the confidence level of the reserve and has, on preliminary analysis, significantly increased the grade of the deposit. A detailed project update is expected to be available in January when final interpretations are complete.

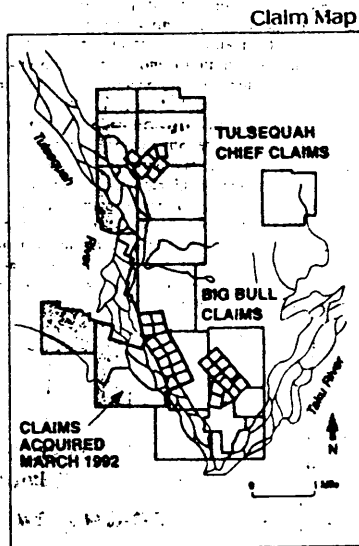
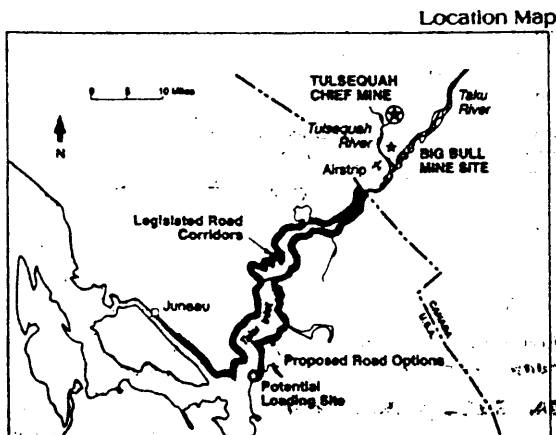
