> AKIKO GOLD RESOURCES LTD. (AKI-V) ROAD CONSTRUCTION COMPLETED - Michael Levinson, chairman, Akiko Gold Resources Ltd., reports SCC Resources Inc. has completed the construction of a 1.5-km road to the Bird Dog zone on the Kit property, on Wild Horse River, 30 km NE of Cranbrook, B.C. and about 40 km from Cominco's Sullivan mine at Kimberley. Several trenches were samples within the coincident geochemical/geophysical Bird Dog anomaly. Unusually severe snow conditions in December forced suspension of the program. Exploration will ' recommence as weather permits. Two samples from different trenches yielded significant values. Sample KT 92-3 contains 21.2% lead and 14.28

Sample KT 92-3 contains 21.2% lead and 14.28 oz.silver/ton. This sample consists of a quartz stock-work in Proterozoic Aldridge sediments.

Sample KT 9202 contains 0.91 oz.gold/ton (31.2 g/t) and 2.36% lead. This sample was taken from an as yet undefined shear zone in Aldridge sediments.

The significance and extent of the high gold value remains undetermined pending further field work and drilling. This analysis may be significant in that it occurs in the Aldridge formation at a location on the Wild Horse River near the uppermost location of placer gold production.(SEE GCNL No.22, 2Feb93, P.4 FOR OTHER INFORMATION)
