10,000-FOOT DRILL PROGRAM UNDERWAY - J. Frank Callaghan,
president, reports

Wayside Gold Mines Ltd. and 50/50 partner Brigadier Resources Ltd. have begun an additional 10,000 feet of underground drilling from the 9th level at the Wayside gold mine, Goldbridge, B.C. Two underground drills will operate two shifts per day. To date, seven drill holes have been completed, totalling 1,700 feet, which intercepted the Notman vein structure from the 9th level of the underground workings 550 feet below surface; assays will be forthcoming. The target was the Chevron Minerals 87-1 hole which was drilled from surface and intercepted 5.23 feet of 1.84 oz. gold/t at about the 9th level. "Between 5-9 levels, if the vein is continuous, it may contain significant tonnage, estimated at 58,000 tons." (Sampson 1992)

Drill hole 93-8, in progress, from the 9th level is targeted at the Main vein and is being drilled at -55° bearing 065° to test the down-dip extension. There is a well ribboned mineralized quartz vein in the first 15 feet. The hole will be carried to 400 feet and several intersections are expected. The target on this hole is the 15 feet of 1.76 oz. gold/t. Intersection by hole 80-S-10 in this structure has also been cut by Chevron's 1987-88 drill program as well as the companies' 1991 drill program which "show approximately 300 feet of gold-bearing ground occurring on the Main Wayside vein between the 9th level and the drill intersections. At an average width of 19 feet, and a strike of 200 feet, this would contain 50,000 tons." (Sampson 1992). (SEE GCNL No.234, 4Dec92 P.2 FOR PREVIOUS DATA)

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
