UNDERGROUND EXPLORATION CONTINUES - J. Frank Callaghan, president, Wayside

Gold Mines and 50/50 joint venture partner Brigadier Resources have reported further investigation of the Chevron Minerals 1988 work program and report identified the upward continuation of the Main Wayside vein structure. Drill hole 88-10 drilled 100 metres above the paxton adit, the highest adit above the lake intersected a 2-metre wide vein with low gold values. 300 metres below this intersection, Chevron Minerals 88-11 drill hole intersected a 2.8-metre wide vein also with low gold values. With these results in hand, Sampson Engineering explored O adit, at 700 feet above lake level, the half way point between both drill holes and found the portal in good condition. A grab sample No. 93284 (submitted for assay 21Jan93) assayed 4.814 oz.gold/ton. A caterpillar excavator en route to the cave-in on 150 level opened a new vein 50 metres west of the portal, which will be sampled and assayed.

The Wayside Gold Mine, located in Goldbridge, B.C. is situated near the Bralorne, Pioneer and King Mines. Collectively, the camps have produced over 4,200,000 oz. gold and over 900,000 oz. silver. (SEE GCNL No.28,
