TWO EXPLORATION PROGRAMS UNDERWAY - Donald A. McLeod, president has

reported Tenajon Resources, and 50/50 joint venture partner Westmin Resources has started work on the SB gold property near Stewart in NW B.C. The Alimak Raise has been collared and is in progress towards it's target of the Kansas/West Kansas zones. The company is currently exploring the Storm Zone located within 15 metres of the underground workings of the SB property. The Storm Zone was discovered in 1990, but was not further tested since then. The Storm Zone discovery hole contained 23 feet of 1.1 oz gold/ton which was interpreted to be an oblique intersection of a new ore-bearing structure.

Four diamond drill holes totalling 565 feet have just been completed on the Storm Zone. This drilling has shown the Storm Zone to be a faulted-off portion of the 35 ore Zone, with high grade gold along the fault plane. Assays are expected shortly from the four new holes.
