Resources Ltd. reports receipt of further assays for Battle/Gap Zone drill holes completed prior to the work stoppage on 24Apr93 at the Myra Falls mining operations west of Campbell River, Vancouver Island, B.C. Gold and silver results have been obtained for most of the base metal holes announced in April and May but are not considered sufficiently significant to release them on their own.
