CANMARK INTERNATIONAL RESOURCES INC. [CIMP-V] ZEOLITE DISCOVERED AT PRINCETON - Roy Wellman, president,

reports Canmark International Resources Inc. has made a significant zeolite discovery at it's Sunday Creek claims (Sun claims) near Princeton B.C. Ten diamond drill holes encountered commercial values in six holes of highly adsorptive zeolite (clinoptilolite) contained within the perimeter defined by the drill holes. Considered proven are 50,000 tons of high quality material plus 80,000 tons probable. Zeolite is a mineral which can absorb gases and eliminate odours.

The company will begin Phase II including diamond drilling to prove-up additional reserves, permitting, limited production mining and stockpiling substantial tonnage over the next five months to meet the demand of commercial clients. Canmark will mine, process and package the industrial minerals in the town of Princeton.

In a related development, Mr. Ronald Gamble paid \$100,000 for a 3% royalty on gross tonnage sales from zeolite mined at the Sun claims. Further financing has been arranged to completely fund exploration, mining and processing operations. Canmark can earn a 100% interest in the property by issuing 200,000 shares in stages.
