LA ROCK MINING CORP. (LAR-V)

NATIVE GOLD/SILVER IN CORE - Martial Levasseur, president, La Rock Mining Corp., reports current diamond drilling has intersected the favourable horizon with the drill core containing visible gold and silver at the Brandywine project 30 miles north of Squamish, B.C. The company has a 100% interest subject to a 0.5% NSR. The drilling is designed to test a large synform Britannia Beach model of dacite-andesite tuffs for base and precious metals. The first step-out hole 3,000 feet south from the high grade Tedi pit drilled in 1992 successfully located the dacite tuff host horizon which was intensely foliated and contained rolled pebbles of sulphide mineralization. A projection of the foliation leads to a strong deeply buried electromagnetic conductor in more difficult terrain that will be tested this spring. A second step-out hole an additional 3,000 feet south to within 800 feet east of the high grade Main showing which returned 2.94 oz.gold/ton, 12.5 oz.silver/ton, 9.9% lead and 7.4% zinc from a 2,000-lb bulk sample shipped to the smelter in East Helena in 1964, intersected mineralized dacite tuff.
