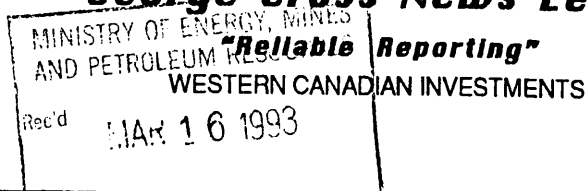

NEW CANAMIN RESOURCES LTD. (NNI-V)

HUCKLEBERRY DRILLING TO RESUME - Alan Savage, president,
reports New Canamin

Resources Ltd. will resume diamond drilling on its new discovery at the
Huckleberry property 20Mar93. The project, in which the company
can earn a 100% interest from Kennecott by spending \$1,500,000 on
exploration over five years, is located 130 km southwest of Houston
and 25 miles east of Kemano, B.C. Kennecott can back-in for 60%.

The program will consist of five holes designed to test the extent
of mineralization around diamond drill hole 93-26. The hole, which
ended in mineralization, tested only 25 feet grading 0.90% copper after
penetrating 110 feet of glacial till. DDH 93-26 was drilled and
completed as a water quality monitoring well in the area of a proposed
tailings dam about 1,150 meters east of the proposed open pit at the
